# THE TOWNSHIP'S STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS

The development of the Township's new strategic plan has been a collaborative and thorough process, reflecting the dedication of our community to shape a brighter future for South-West Oxford. This process began in January, 2023, shortly after the 2022 municipal election. We were fortunate to partner with Climb Consulting Inc., a trusted and valued guide throughout our strategic planning process, to help Council and staff navigate the community consultation process ahead.

Throughout our consultation process, Council and staff were presented with critical questions to define our path forward:

- What are the Township's greatest strengths and limitations?
- What are the most important and pressing challenges, risks and opportunities that this plan must address?
- Looking ahead five years, what is Council's vision for South-West Oxford?
- What are the outcomes Council wants to deliver for the residents served?
- In light of Council's vision, and thinking about the complex environment that the Township operates in, what are the most important strategic priorities for South-West Oxford to focus on over the next five years?

To ensure that our community's voice was heard, in February, 2023, we launched a comprehensive online community consultation survey to guide the development of our new Strategic Plan. The Township promoted the survey through various communication channels, including the Village Voice, our website, and our presence on social media platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter. The Township is pleased to share that we received over 250 responses to the survey, reflecting active engagement of our community.

Recognizing the value of in-person interactions, we hosted community consultation sessions at multiple locations. These sessions, held at the Mount Elgin Community Centre, Beachville Legion, Brownsville Community Centre, and a special gathering with members of the Township Hall and Park Board members in Brownsville in April, 2023, allowed for deeper, face to face discussions and further enriched our understanding of the community's aspirations. With a draft strategic map complete, the Township held one final in-person community consultation session as part of our regular Council meeting on September 19th, 2023.

This process has been a testament to our commitment to transparency and collaboration. As we move forward with the implementation of our new strategic plan, rest assured your input will be the cornerstone of our decision-making. Together, we will shape a future for South-West Oxford that we can all be proud of.
